- Sub.: 1. Use of Mobile Phones in the College premises
2. Wearing of I-Card in the Campus

1. Use of Mobile Phones in the College premises :

The College Management has issued guidelines on the subject of use of Mobiles in the College premises. In spite of being aware that use of mobile phones is strictly prohibited in the College premises, students tend to use the same in corridors, class rooms, Labs, Library, etc., in the College premises. The Management has taken a serious note of the same and would like to give a clear message to all the students that the use of Mobile phones in the College premises will not be tolerated.

As a first step, if any student is found using mobile phone, the same will be confiscated. The mobile phone will be returned after five working days subject to payment of Rs.100/- as fine and giving an Undertaking that the same mistake will not be repeated.

Management will not hesitate to take further action in the matter including increase in fine and confiscating the mobile phone till the end of their Engineering Course.

2. Wearing the I-Card in the Campus :

It is matter of deep regret that many of the students fail to wear their Identity Cards in the College Campus. It has been observed that the Security Guards have to remind every time to wear the I-Card before students enter the campus. Moreover, it is also observed that many of the students do not wish to wear their I-Card in the class rooms, Lab., etc., when they are in the College premises.

Students are once again reminded that it is mandatory to all the students to wear their I-Cards in the College campus. If any student fail to wear the I-Card, in addition to a fine of Rs.50/-, the Class Teacher / Subject Teacher / Lab Incharge are authorised not to mark their attendance and for repeated mistake, they can send the student out of the Class / Lab.

All the students are required to note the above in the right spirit and abide by the rules and regulations in order to maintain discipline in their own interest.
